









## NCI: An Overview




## Population addressed

- NCI-IDD: People with IDD
- NCI-AD: Older adults and people with physical disabilities
- All receiving LTSS

## NCI: A Person-centered Approach

- Standardized survey with a sample of individuals receiving services
  - No pre-screening procedures
- Survey includes:
  - Demographic and service-related characteristics typically from existing records
  - Main survey section conducted with person receiving services
  - Some questions may be answered by a proxy respondent
- Survey conducted in-person or via video conference
  - NCI-AD were conducted in 2018-19 and all in-person
- Standardized surveyor training
- Allows questions to be reworded or rephrased using familiar names and terms
- Survey portions take 50 minutes on average

# NCI-IDD: Slight increases in 55 and older groups






Gender gap closes in older cohorts for NCI-IDD, increases NCI-AD

- NCI-IDD
  - 44% 55-64
  - 47% 65-74
  - 50% 75 and older
- NCI-AD
  - 54% 55-64
  - 68% 65-74
  - 71% 75 and older



#### Outcomes 2020-21

## NCI-IDD younger cohorts are more diverse\*\*




NCI-AD differences by race for people with DD are not statistically significant, however, slightly higher proportion of people black/African American and lower proportion of people who are white in younger cohorts.


# NCI-IDD respondents in the older cohort were twice as likely to live in an institutional setting

## NCI-IDD: Mental health conditions are more prevalent in younger cohort




## NCI-AD: Self-reported mental health diagnosis:

- 28% 65-74


## NCI-IDD: Three times as many people 55-64 have ASD compared to those 75 and older\*\*






More NCI-IDD respondents in the older cohort reported they like their home, but fewer engaged in community activities they like

#### Age Group and Community




■ 55-64 ■ 65-74 ■ 75 and older

## NCI-AD Community Outcomes People With DD





#### NCI-IDD: Age Group and Friends



Respondents to NCI-IDD in the older cohort were less likely to report they have friends and can see and talk with friends when they want.
