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## Collapsing and Weighting Responses

For many of the outcomes in Part 1 of this report, only “yes” responses are analyzed and reported for state-to-state comparisons. However, there are several items for which the “yes” responses were collapsed with the middle responses (for example, a “sometimes” response, or an “in-between” response) to form binary variables for analysis and subsequent reporting.

All data reported in Part 1 of this report are “weighted” to account for oversampling by programs within states. Additionally, the NCI-AD Average and the overall program category averages are also weighted averages in order to take into account each state’s sample size as well as the size of the state’s population eligible to be included in the survey sample. **Read more about Weighting in the Data Analysis section of Part 1 of the report.**

Data presented in this section show the un-collapsed and unweighted state and NCI-AD averages.
